

**Subject: Cyber Security Advisory – Awareness Regarding Fraudulent/Fake E-mail (Advisory No. 10)**

Reportedly, a fake e-mail address **Assistant\_Secretary\_NTISB@mail.com** is being used to circulate bogus security advisories containing malicious attachments/payloads in the name of Assistant Secretary NTISB-II (**Annex A**). All the Ministries/Divisions/Departments are requested to, “**Remain vigilant, Do not respond to the email and Do not open the malicious attachment/Payload**”.
