 - iv. Any other issue relevant to the scope of work assigned to the committee.
3. Committee may co-opt any additional member(s) on need basis.
 4. The Committee shall submit its recommendations by 15-08-2024 for consideration of the Prime Minister.
 5. The Cabinet Division (Institutional Reforms Cell) shall provide secretarial support to the committee.




