2. Terms of Reference:

- i. Act as the central forum to decide cross-cutting issues of all governmental agencies dealing with overseas employment and the TVET sectors;
- ii. Oversee functioning of the National TVET Coordination Committee;
- iii. Authorize review of current policies, programs, and initiatives in the TVET sector to identify prevalent weaknesses and development of plans for leveraging technology to address these issues;
- iv. Approve mechanisms for quality assurance, accreditation, and certification of vocational training programs and institutions;



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- v. Approve monitoring and evaluation frameworks to track progress, performance, and impact of technical and vocational training initiatives;
- vi. Approve guidelines for the development, standardization, and modernization of technical and vocational training curricula to align with industry (domestic and international) requirements and international best practices;
- vii. Approve programs for the professional development, training, and capacity building of vocational instructors, trainers, and educators;
- viii. Approve plans for curbing exploitation of skilled workers, HR smuggling and illegal emigration; and
- ix. Authorize action plans for engagement with relevant international multilateral partners and fora.

3. The Cabinet Committee may co-opt any person as a member or may require attendance of any person by special invitation as it deems appropriate.

4. No act, decision or proceedings of the Cabinet Committee shall be invalid by reason of absence, vacancy or defect in the constitution of the Committee.
