OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: - Proposals for decentralization/delegation of powers
Recommendations and decisions of the Two-Member Committee.

The undersigned is directed to state that in pursuance of President's address to Secretaries on the subject of decentralization and delegation of powers and the recommendations of the "Two Member Committee" the Competent authority has taken the following decisions :-

i) New telephone connections for offices

The power to sanction new telephone connections for the offices has been delegated to Secretaries of the Ministerial Divisions concerned.

ii) Residential Telephones

The powers of approving residential telephones for officers who were ordinarily not entitled to such telephones will remain with the Cabinet Division.

iii) Maintenance of Trunk Call Registers

It has been found that writing of all calls in telephone registers was generally a difficult exercise. The Committee therefore, decided to do away with the requirement of maintaining Trunk Call Registers in view of the common facility of STD/NWD. The control over the use of official telephones should be exercised through the expenditure limits prescribed for both office and residential telephones.

2. The undersigned is accordingly directed to request that the above referred decisions may please be noted for future action.
3. All previous instructions on the subject may please be treated as modified to above extent.
