TO THE AWARDS IN THE ORDER OF SHUJA'AT AND
"PRESIDENT'S AWARD FOR PRIDE OF PERFORMANCE".

Sir,

I am directed to state that the question of enhancement in the monetary benefits attached to the awards in the Order of Shuja'at and President's Award for Pride of Performance was under consideration of the Federal Government. It has therefore been decided to revise the benefits attached to the civil awards which are as follows:-

Name of Award	Lump sum grant for awardees who are alive	Lump sum grant for posthumous awardees or seriously disabled
Nishan-i-Shuja'at	Rs.1,200,000/-	Rs.1,500,000/-
Hilal-i-Shuja'at	Rs.1,000,000/-	Rs.1,300,000/-
Sitara-i-Shuja'at	Rs.900,000/-	Rs.1,100,000/-
Tamgha-i-Shuja'at	Rs.300,000/-	Rs.900,000/-
President's Award for Pride of Performance	Rs.1,000,000/-	Rs.1,000,000/-

The above benefits shall be admissible subject to the following conditions:-


- i) In the case of a deceased male awardee, the widow shall get the lump sum grant.
- ii) In the case of a deceased female awardee the lump sum grant shall be paid to the husband.
- iii) If the spouse of the awardee had pre-deceased the awardee, the minor children of the awardee, if any, will be entitled to receive payment of the lump sum grant.
- iv) If the awardee is not survived by either a spouse or minor children, the dependent parents will get the lump sum grant.
- v) If the awardee is unmarried or is not survived by either a spouse or minor children or dependent parents, government may in its discretion make payment of the lump sum grant to such other legal heirs of the awardee, and in such proportions, as it may deem appropriate in each case.

3. This supersedes Cabinet Division's letter No.1/14/2010-Awards dated 17th January, 2011. The above order shall come into force with effect from 14th August, 2015 and until further order.
