

**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

Subject: **PROVISION OF RESIDENTIAL TELEPHONE FACILITY**

The undersigned is directed to refer to Ministry of Economic Affairs & Statistics O.M.No.8(2)EAD/G/2005, dated 03<sup>rd</sup> October, 2005 on the above mentioned subject and to inform that a clarification regarding duration for retention of official residential telephone after the death of an officer was analyzed by the "Committee on Telephones" comprising of the Cabinet and Finance Divisions in its 9<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 06<sup>th</sup> May, 2006. The Committee observed that the officers proceeding on LPR are not allowed to retain the official residential telephone. The facility is disconnected from the day of commencement of LPR. However, in such a situation special relaxation is recommended for retention of residential telephone for four (4) months by the widow of a deceased and entitled officer. The above instructions shall be brought to the notice of all Ministries/Divisions for compliance.
